GUIDELINES FOR AWARDING SCHOLARSHIPS

1. All applicants must be a high school graduate (or will graduate at the end of the school year during the year of application) or a college student.
2. All applicants must be children or grandchildren, step-children or step-grandchildren of an active or retired dues-paid member of IACCR.
3. All applicants must be under 22 years of age on June 1, 2012.
4. Any application received by the Chair of the Scholarship Committee after the date of June 1, shall not be considered by the Committee. Further, an incomplete application will not be considered.
5. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of a Chairman and four other members, all of whom shall be named by the President. In the event an applicant is related to any member of the Committee, the member shall not participate in the selection of the winner.
6. The criteria for selection by the scholarship committee shall be based on the following: (a) scholastic ability (b) need (c) leadership and activity.
7. The student's grade point average will be considered, but grades will not be the only determining factor. The needs of the applicant, whether the student is receiving any other scholarships, the student's sincere desire to attend college and any other pertinent information will be considered.
